The jury will make its decision based on the following criteria:

- The relevance and technical feasibility of the topic (1-10)
- A clear statement of the objective of the work (1-10)
- The adequacy of the used methods (1-15)
- The validity and reliability of achieved results (1-15)
- The innovative character of the work carried out (1-15)
- The accuracy of the explanation of the work in written material and in oral presentation (1-15)
- The graphical quality of the summary, the presentation and the poster (1-10)
- The candidate's ability to argue during the discussion (1-10)

Each jury member will give a list with the candidates ordered from the first to the last position.

<u>Instructions</u>

Competing student(s) shall prepare for the competition:

- 1) 12 minutes' oral presentation of their work (15 slides maximum) with 3 minutes for questions and answers
- 2) A1 size technical poster (vertical oriented) to be displayed at the conference room
