

- 38 Articles (2.3 times > 2002)
- 10 Annexes (10 times > 2002)







Building performance is acomplex & ongoing process! Assessment – Certification – Management

We have seen what happens if building performance is over-simplified > it's perceived as just an administrative burden!

Results stemming from the Next Gen EPC and SRI clusters are making it possible to immediately and adequately consider building performance \rightarrow the twin green & digital energy transition!

LIFE Clean Energy Transition (CET)

Direct support for policy implementation:

- Create market and regulatory enabling conditions for the clean energy transition
- Improve governance and capacities/skills at all levels
- Mobilise investments and improve access to finance
- Empower Citizens
- Develop and replicate best practices













Defined main intervention areas:

- Annual calls for proposals: Deadline 19th September 2024
- 95% co-funding for most topics
- Projects indicative budget ≈ 1.5 2 € million
- Consortia: Most topics minimum 3 eligible countries, some topics national/regional focus








EPBD.wise in a nutshel

→EPBD.wise provides on-the-ground support to six countries for the implementation of the EPBD *recast* (**Bulgaria, Greece, Hungary, Poland, Romania, and Ukraine**).

→EPBD.wise provides on-the-ground support for the implementation of 5 key elements of the EPBD:

- National Building Renovation Plans
- Minimum Energy Performance Standards
- Energy Performance Certificates
- Building Renovation Passports
- Zero Emission Buildings







Goals of the project 🌐

- Support Member States in aligning new policies with EPBD and European, national, and regional targets
- > Assist in ensuring consistency among policies affecting buildings to enhance their impact
- Integrate monitoring and reporting mechanisms into policy design for continuous evaluation
- Enhance understanding and knowledge of building policy planning and design among public administrations
- ➤ Foster collaboration among implementing bodies within and across Member States for effective EPBD implementation





Ongoing work at the national level

- Reports on policy needs and best practices for each topic, and focused on specific countries, will be published soon!
- The first round of national policy forums are taking place in May – June 2024.
 - ➤ Already taken place in Bulgaria, Greece and Romania
 - > As we speak it is taking place in Hungary today
 - Coming soon for Poland and Ukraine
- This is important preparatory work for our upcoming policy guidelines for focus countries on the topics that have been identified

Phase 1: Understanding policy needs & status quo Phase 2: Intensive policy support in focus countries. Phase 3: Replication of results to EU-27 & beyond Phase 4: Final communication. dissemination & exploitation



National Building Renovation Plans

These plans are coming in 2025 / 2026 and they will be a crucial planning tool to achieve a zero-emission building stock by 2050!

- ➤ Challenges identified: lack of (detailed) data, difficult to derive actionable strategies based on current data, missing link to clear funding instruments
- Countries need support on: robust data collection and analysis methodologies, methodology on cost calculations, operationalising renovation plans, identifying investments, integrating these plans with broader economic and environmental policies

Minimum Energy Performance Standards

MEPS are one of the cornerstone policy measures to achieve the NBRP renovation targets!

> Some of the challenges: lack of (detailed) data similar to NBRPs, identification of worst-performing buildings, demographic challenge, high cost of EPCs, stop-and-go funding





Energy Performance Certificates and Building Renovation Passports

Some of the challenges: quality control mechanisms, quality of EPC databases, cost of EPCs, public perception of EPCs, lack of skilled auditors, interoperability or integration with renovation passports, introduction of the smart readiness indicator








BRG Example: Problem Tree

A Problem Tree helps to understand the underlying causality of the most important issues


PROBLEM TREE LOGIC
